## **Lifeguard Staff**

The Village of Pleasant Prairie Park & Recreation Lifeguard Staff is licensed under the top national waterpark safety program, Ellis & Associates. The lifeguard staff must complete and pass a 20-hour training program, which includes lifeguard rescue skills, emergency procedures and community CPR & AED. The guards must also attend monthly in-service training sessions and participate in surprise simulations. Throughout the year, auditors from Ellis & Associates conduct unannounced visits to audit staff performance and skills.

#### **Personal Conduct**

- ALL Aquatic Center users MUST shower before entering the pool area
- NO street shoes on pool deck: only aquatic footwear is allowed in the pool area: shower shoes, water shoes
- Swimsuits ONLY. No leotards, cut-offs, denim, cotton, t-shirts
- · Children who are not toilet trained MUST wear swim diapers
- PLEASE, no spitting, spouting of water or blowing the nose in the water
- Boisterous, rough play and running are not allowed
- Persons violating personal conduct regulations, written or verbal, may be subject to disciplinary action or asked to leave without a refund.
- NO RUNNING
- All other state and local health laws apply

## **Supervision of children**

- · Parents or guardians must be responsible for supervising their children
- Lifeguards are on duty only to enforce rules and to respond in case of an emergency
- Children 7-9 years old MUST be accompanied IN THE POOL AREA by an adult
- Children 4-6 years old MUST be accompanied IN THE POOL by an adult
- Children 3 & under MUST be accompanied IN THE POOL by an adult, WITHIN ARMS REACH

# **Play Toys & Floatation Devices**

- No play toys are allowed
- No floatation devices are allowed: noodles, tubes, rafts, etc.
- US COAST GUARD approved Personal Floatation Devices (PFD): Type I, II, III: this is stamped on the PFD
- NO WATER WINGS or FLOATATION SWIMSUITS or VESTS

# Food/Beverages

- Food and beverages are available at the concession stand: NO carry-ins
- Food may not be brought into the water
- Eating and drinking are permitted ONLY on the concession tables
- Please throw garbage into the trash containers

## **Safety Concerns**

- · Chewing gum, tobacco, food, & drink are not allowed in the pool
- Glass & shatterable plastic items are not permitted in the pool area
- No smoking in RecPlex
- Do not enter the pool if you have a communicable disease or an open cut
- Rules may be added or waived by the management when appropriate
- Do not bring animals into the pool area
- SHALLOW water facility: NO DIVING is allowed in any area

#### **Water Slide Rules**

- Riders MUST be 42"
- 1 rider at a time: NO double riding
- Please wait for the lifeguards instructions
- It is recommended that pregnant woman and individuals with heart conditions or back problems refrain from using the slide.
- All riders MUST slide down on their back, FEET FIRST WITH HANDS BEHIND THEIR HEAD OR ACROSS CHEST
- Sliding down headfirst is prohibited.
- Stopping intentionally on the slide is strictly prohibited.
- Stopping, standing, kneeling, and rotating in the slide are not allowed.
- Hands **MUST** be kept inside the flume.
- Please exit the slide pool immediately after each ride.
- Rowdy play or not adhering to established rules will result in loss of slide privileges and possible expulsion from the facility.
- Please wait your turn, no line jumping
- Please walk up the stairs, no running
- Additional rules may be added by the management staff.

#### **Kiddie Slide**

- No more than 2 on the slide at one time: one on each side
- All riders MUST slide down in a sitting position: FEET FIRST
- Sliding down headfirst is prohibited
- Climbing up the slide is prohibited
- Please exit the bottom of the slide immediately
- Rowdy play or not adhering to established rules will result in loss of slide privileges and possible expulsion from the facility.
- Please wait your turn
- Please walk up the stairs, **NO running**
- Additional rules may be added by the management staff.

## **SCS Water Playground Rules**

- No more than 1 rider on the slide
- Please wait your turn, do not push others down the slide
- All riders MUST slide down in a sitting position: FEET FIRST
- Sliding down headfirst is prohibited
- Please exit the bottom of the slide immediately
- Do NOT climb up the slide
- Please walk up the stairs, NO running
- No swinging or climbing the rope lines
- Rowdy play or not adhering to established rules will result in loss of playground privileges and possible expulsion from the facility.
- Do NOT jump off of the stairs
- Additional rules may be added by the management staff.

## Current Channel: water depth is 42" with moving current- Field trips do not get use of this area

- Children under 46" MUST be accompanied by an adult within an arm's reach
- Please enter & exit the current channel from the 2 designated areas
- Do not jump into the current from the sides or jump from the ladder
- Children using the current MUST be able to swim independently

#### **Lap Swim Area:** shallow water: 42"-52" - Field trips do not get use of this area

- This is a designated lap swimming area: adults have priority in the lanes
- Circle swim: when 2 or more are in 1 lane
- West lane: slow lane
- NO diving

## Whirlpool Maximum capacity: 17 Maximum temperature: 104\* - Field trips do not get use of this area

- Elderly persons and persons suffering from heart disease, diabetes, or high low blood pressure should not enter the whirlpool
- Children (under age 12) may NOT use the whirlpool
- Children 12-16 MUST be accompanied by an adult
- Person under the influence of alcohol or drugs may not use the whirlpool
- Pregnant women should consult their physician regarding whirlpool usage
- · Lengthy exposure may be hazardous to your health and may result in nausea, dizziness, or faint
